There is a provision by SACHIS to analyze the claims received under "Ayushman Bharat-Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojna" on a regular basis. It has been observed through these data trends that the claims raised under General Medicine have shown an increasing trend. While processing the claims it has been observed that in maximum claims OPD cases are being converted into IPD and that to in ICU/HDU ward. In this regard, it is directed that below points needs to be incorporated while putting of claims.

- Only routine ward is allowed for UTI patients:- All EHCP are directed that for UTI cases ICU/HDU admission will not be considered and only routine ward will be allowed for maximum of three days. If further enhancement is required, hospitals will have to provide urine culture investigation report.
- 2. Mandatory document for ICU/ HDU admission:- All EHCP are directed to provide documents required for ICU/HDU admission signed by MD-Medicine /MD- Anaesthesia/MD-TB Chest or any other specialist doctor along with their stamp (Name, Degree and Registration No) mentioning the reason for ICU /HDU admission for that particular disease. These documents are mandatory and should be uploaded on TMS portal. If EHCP fails to provide the above mentioned documents and if ICU/HDU documents are signed by MBBS doctor, the claim will be rejected and would not be revoked in future.
- **3.** GPS Enabled Photograph of all ICU/HDU cases are mandatory:- All ICU/HDU cases, GPS enabled photograph with date, time and location are mandatory. These photographs should be uploaded twice in a day (with difference of minimum eight hours) on TMS Portal.
